



## Honoree Lew Barnes

Lew was raised in Southeast San Diego by his parents, Phyllis and William Barnes. His father was an Engineer for the City of San Diego Fire Department, and most impressively, a chartering member of the Brothers United Black Firefighters Union. His mother, Phyllis Barnes, retired from San Diego Unified School District supporting the training and development of personal health for elementary students. A really interesting fact about his mom was that she courageously planned and participated in sit-ins at nonsegregated restaurants and helped establish the NAACP chapter in Kansas City, Kansas.

Lew graduated from Lincoln High School, attended Mesa Jr College, and the University of Oregon where he earned many accolades for his accomplishments in football, including All-American, All Pac 10, and was a captain for two years. At the end of his time at the University of Oregon, he was drafted by the Chicago Bears. From there, he also played with the Atlanta Falcons and Kansas City Chiefs. After his career ended, he eventually became and still is employed at San Diego Gas and Electric, and has been there for the past 25 years. He has coached high school and Pop Warner Football, along with Youth Track and Field over the last 20 years, and is currently the Head Football Coach at Olympian High School in Chula Vista, CA.




He has also mentored high school athletes and Debutant Escorts. His commitment to his community never ceases. He regularly helps with planning for the Southeast Martin Luther King parade as well as participates in it. # Honoree Fred Denham

While at Bell Labs, Fredrick enrolled in graduate courses at Illinois Institute of Technology and the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), completing the Master of Science Degree in Computer Science from UCLA in 1990. Mr. Denham continued his professional journey at NCR Corporation (El Segundo, California, 1993-1999) and Teradata, Inc. (San Diego, CA, 1999-present). As an established professional with



over 40 years of experience in the Information Technology industry, Fredrick's positions of responsibility have included telecommunications and database software engineering, team leadership, operations management and project management. In 2003, Fredrick earned the Project Management Professional (PMP ®) certification from the Project Management Institute. Since 1999, Fredrick has resided in Temecula, California, with his wife of 32 years, Deneen, and three sons - Fredrick, II (28), Bryce (26) and Jaden (22). 

# Fire Capt. Jonathan **Harris**

Jonathan Harris was born on January 9, 1981, to John and Loretta Harris at Grossmont Hospital in La Mesa, California. Raised in Spring Valley, Jonathan developed a deep love for sports, especially basketball, from a young age. He excelled as a multi-sport athlete at Monte Vista High School, graduating in 1999. His talent on the court earned him a basketball scholarship to Milligan College in Johnson City, Tennessee.

At Milligan, a prestigious institution known for its commitment to developing servant leaders, Jonathan embraced the values of hard work and dedication. He earned a degree in Sociology with a minor in Legal Studies, all while excelling on the basketball court. He became a three-time All-American and was later drafted into the World Basketball Association. His professional basketball career took him across the U.S. and abroad, including time in the NBA Development League and in São Paulo, Brazil.

Unfortunately, an injury forced Jonathan to return home and reconsider his path. During his recovery, he joined his brother—already a firefighter—on a ride-along. That experience sparked a new passion in Jonathan: public service through firefighting. Jonathan was hired by the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department in 2012. Known for his work ethic and dedication, he gravitated toward some of the



city's busiest stations, including Station 17 in City Heights and Station 14 in North Park. In 2020, he was promoted to Fire Captain and now leads Station 29 in the South Bay.

Throughout his career, Jonathan has remained committed to giving back. He is deeply involved with Brothers United, an organization of African-American firefighters dedicated to recruitment, retention, and advancement of Black firefighters. Now serving as its President, Jonathan leads efforts in community outreach and mentorship, helping the next generation pursue careers in public service.

In addition to his demanding career, Jonathan has also been a devoted single father to Kylee, who is now 19 and pursuing her dream of becoming a digital artist and entrepreneur. His journey from athlete to public servant stands as a testament to resilience, leadership, and the power of purpose.
